Rational Behind the Study:

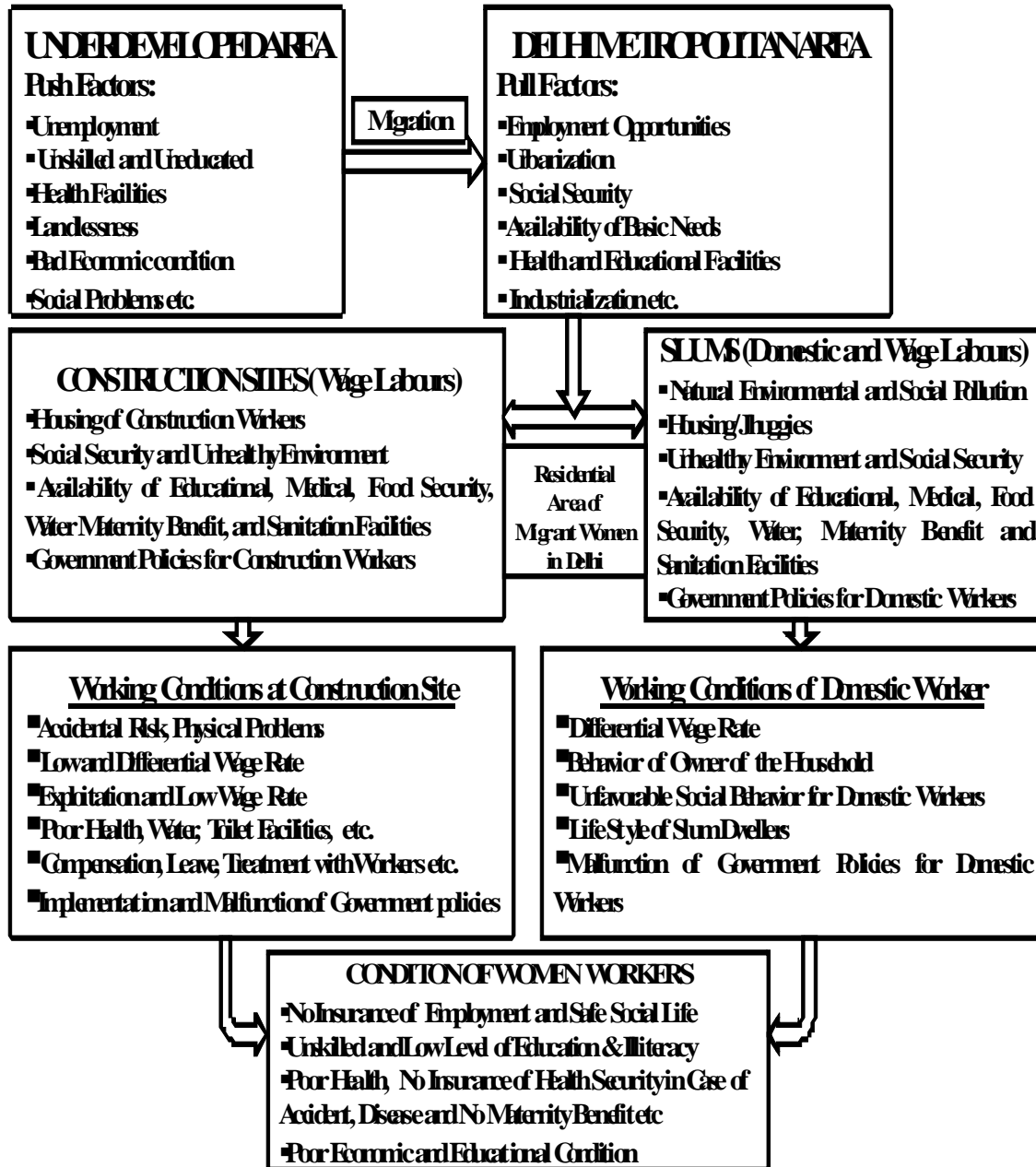
